



The hikes and expeditions organized by Expedition Good Life are intended as fun and rewarding learning experiences. The facilitators of Expedition Good Life will always do as much as they can to make sure you will learn as much as possible. Some things we need to put down on paper so there's no confusion afterwards. These conditions also apply to the hikes organized with Expedition Good Life partners (EL Coaching & Ontwikkel-Werkplaats). Here's what you need to know:

- Signing up for an expedition is done by completing the sign-up form or being agreed on by the organization you work for.
- An invoice will be sent before or after an expedition and needs to be paid at the stated date on the invoice.
- Group sizes are agreed upon in proposal or are stated on the website.
- The goal of the expedition is communicated upfront and if necessary discussed and agreed upon with the target group.
- Expedition Good Life is allowed to cancel the expedition when the minimum group size has not been reached
- Expedition Good Life will do as much as possible to provide a safe and fun learning experience. Expedition Good Life is not responsible for any damage to materials, stolen goods, physical injuries and other injuries or damages during the expedition. During the hike, reckless behavior of a participant can result in exclusion from the expedition.
- If stated and agreed, Expedition Good Life will provide food during an expedition. Expedition Good Life will take dietary wishes into account as much as possible, but is not responsible for any (allergic) reactions to the food provided.
- Participants of an expedition need to be properly insured for physical injuries. Expedition Good Life cannot be held accountable for any injuries or treatment of these injuries after the expedition.
- By agreeing to the terms and conditions, participants indicate they are mentally and physically able to join this expedition. What is expected on the physical level is being communicated on forehand by the facilitator(s) of the expedition.
- Participants are responsible for their transport from and to the starting / ending point of the location before and after the expedition
- An expedition can be cancelled in writing (to [info@expeditiongoodlife.org](mailto:info@expeditiongoodlife.org)). Cancelling can be done free of charge up to 30 days before the start of the expedition. Within 21 days of the expedition, the full fee of the expedition will be charged.
- Expedition Good Life is allowed to cancel the expedition at any time if the facilitator of the expedition is not physically able to host the expedition.
- By agreeing to the terms and conditions, Expedition Good Life is allowed to use pictures taken by the facilitators for (social) media, website and communication.
